

Main results about digital use and usability of minority languages

Strong desire to use languages digitally, in all sociolinguistic domains and for all the purposes where major languages are used

There is a clear demand for increased regional language usage in the public domain

Speakers need support and encouragement re. ability to use languages digitally and their importance as digital content creators

Lack of structural support for minority languages is a serious issue

Digital development is not sustainable if relying only on activists' and volunteers' work
